1. **Call to Order** - President Scott Davis called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

2. **Roll Call**

3. **Approval of Minutes**

The minutes of the November 3, 2025 MSC meeting were reviewed and discussed. Motion by Gene to approve and post online. Second by Rick. Motion approved unanimously.

4. **Officer Reports**

- President – Scott – nothing to report
- Vice President – Garrett – not present
- Treasurer – Dennis – nothing to report

5. **Delegate Reports**

David had sent out a summary of rules changes that were approved by the NSCA, as well as other NSCA business under discussion and review.

6. **Financial Report**

Dennis led the discussion of the 2026 budget.

The Youth and Women account balance is currently \$4,548. With the re-established \$.01 per target fee dedicated to this we will bring in about \$4,000 to the youth/women account, taking us to \$8-9,000 this year. Motion by Kevin to contribute \$5,000 to the Midway USA Foundation event and contribute half of the state shoot main entry for youth shooters 17 years old and under, up to \$3,000, from the youth/women fund. Second by Hans. Motion approved unanimously.

Our current main account balance is \$29,284. Dennis handed out a financial summary for budget purposes. The targets thrown estimate for this year is conservatively 421,000. Last year we threw 443,061 targets. Revenue projection is \$18,652. Expenses are projected at \$21,695. Estimated balance at year end is \$26,241. Motion by Mike to approve the budget. Second by Joel. Motion approved unanimously.

7. **Committee Reports**

Gun Raffle – The raffle gun has been received. Dave procured it through Reeds. Rick printed the raffle tickets and handed some of them out and made arrangements to hand out the other clubs' tickets.

8. **Old Business**

Consideration of Circuit Shoot – discussed working toward doing a circuit shoot in 2027. We would need to procure some major sponsors to do this. The idea would be for each club to voluntarily designate one shoot as part of the circuit shoot.

9. **New Business**

2027 Schedule Options – Kevin reported David Penn has an idea regarding having a Minnesota-equivalent to the Florida shoots, something like a 3-week swing of major Minnesota shoots in the summer. David is planning to attend our next meeting to present his thoughts on this idea.

**10. Adjournment** - Motion by to Mike to adjourn. Second by Denny. Motion approved unanimously. The meeting was adjourned by President Scott Davis at 6:36 pm.
